**II. Demos and Events**

A. Demos

1. Royers-Greaves

The school would like to do the "Ren Fair" fundraiser again this year. The posited dates were 4/29 and 5/6. After discussion (4/29 will conflict with Spring War Camp), it was determined to recommend 5/6 to the school. Since that is the date the coordinator at the school preferred, it is probably the one that it will be. The event will be all outdoors (gym in the event of weather). Advertising will be stronger and earlier this year. Sion will be the point person with the school.

2. Boy Scouts

Margarete was not aware of the contact Osgrim had received regarding the request from the boy scouts for July demos. She will discuss with Osgrim.

B. Events (listed individually)

1. All's Faire

Diana is working on scheduling a planning meeting. There is a new contact with the boy scouts.

2. St. Sebastian Fair.

Plans are in progress. John has several people for the dayboard. Elizabet, Michel and John will meet with the site's Field Captain to determine which portions of the walking course will be used for the walking range. Elizabet was asked about other activities and said she is open to other activities. There should be room for an A&S display and thrown weapons.

3. Nova Schola.

The event is pulling together. Alison is organizing the teachers. The class units will be 45 minutes.

**III. Old Business**

1. Letter to the Populace

Elizabet presented two new drafts for the letter to the populace – one to go to people listed in the Domesday and one for people not listed in the Domesday. With some edits, the letters were approved. Elizabet presented an estimate of \$175 assuming 200 letters. The amount was approved. Finn will follow up regarding obtaining the list from corporate.

**IV. New Business/"For the good of the group"**

1. Community Outreach for Royers-Greaves school

The school is in need for some painting in the main building. They are looking for "work crews." This project is in the early planning stages, looking at a March date. The plan is to have an evening for prep work during the week (spackling, etc.) then the painting on Saturday. It was suggested that we recommend a Sunday as being more likely to be able to pull together a crew, since even if it conflicts with local events they will be on Saturday. There are other groups the school is going to work with on this project and at least one of them also recommended a Sunday. The date of March 4 was posited. More will be posted.
